Policies and Procedures

Fees – Fees are to be paid per term and need to be finalised by **Week 2** of each term. Fees can be paid in cash, or direct deposit and all fees paid will receive a receipt for your records. **All fees are non-refundable and non-transferable once paid.** If students miss a lesson, they are more than welcome to make it up by attending another/similar class. If there are any problems with fee payment, please see Melissa for an alternative payment schedule. (Please **note:** students will not be able to perform in the concert unless all of their term fees, costume deposits and final costume payments have been paid). _____

Classes – Class times have been scheduled for 2023 however; Instyle reserves the right to modify the timetable as required. Parents are allowed to watch their children for the last 10 minutes of class at the end of every term – Week 10 (except for Term 4, as we will be preparing for our annual concert). _____

Uniform and grooming – Students must be neatly attired and in the **studio uniform at all times** for the appropriate class. Parents are responsible for purchasing the correct dance wear and dance shoes for each class. Student's hair is to be in a bun (for ballet) or in a neat ponytail (jazz, tap, acro). Students who attend class dressed in the incorrect attire and without hair neatly done will be restricted from attending the class. _____
